Membership conditions

EuMBC purpose

EuMBC is a non-profit organisation. Its objective is the study and discussion of scientific, technical, economical and institutional matters, which are of common interest to European Masterbatchers and Compounders with a view of promoting international collaboration.

Membership eligibility

- Manufacture compounds and / or masterbatches in the EU
- EFTA countries and Turkey Votes on EU related issues can only be made by members established in the EU

Membership benefits

Members can participate actively and take benefits from the following activities:

- Participate in the EuMBC Substance Monitoring Group (SMEG): technical, regulatory & monitoring activities for the association members.
- Support on REACH including general information and guidance, specific substance monitoring, REACH tools for risk assessment, safety data sheets.
- Participate in FREP (Food Contact Regulatory Expert Panel).
- Active in the development of the PESTOOL (Plastics Exposure Scenario Tool).
- Free access to the annual EuMBC Conference and the EuMBC General Assembly.
- Regular information & updates on important topics concerning the industry.
- Cooperation & exchange within EuPC (European Plastics Converters Association).
- Participate in market sectors activities alongside the plastic converters and better understand their views (market sectors include Packaging, Building & Construction, Automotive, Electrical & Electronic, Medical & Pharma).
- Participate in horizontal activities and issues on e.g. energy policy, labour cost, trade issues, HSE & Raw Materials Committees.

Membership conditions

Membership organisation

EuMBC shall have three categories of members:

- Full Members (FM) are companies who fulfil entirely the conditions set in the Membership eligibility criteria.
- Associated Members (ASM) are companies that do not fulfil the criteria of the Full Members but are interested in the Working Group activities and can contribute to achieve the object of EuMBC as stated under art. 3.1, e.g. pigments/specialties producers and research institutes. Associated members are entitled to participate to the General Assembly but do not have voting rights.
- EuMBC Friends (Friends) are companies that do not fulfil the criteria of Associated Members but are interested in EuMBC overall external activities e.g. machinery producers. Friends are not entitled to participate to the General Assembly.

Admission of new members shall be subject to the following conditions: an application shall be addressed in writing to the registered office of the Sector Group. The Board shall verify whether the applicant fulfils the conditions of membership. The application for access shall be submitted to the EuMBC General Assembly Group for approval and accepted by an affirmative vote by mail of two thirds majority of the members of the present or represented at the General Assembly.

Resignation of membership will be made in writing and sent by registered letter to the office of the Sector Group at least six months prior to the end of the current membership year. If the resignation is served less than six months before this date, the membership will cease at the end of the following membership year.
